

**FREEBORN-MOWER COOPERATIVE SERVICES**

RESIDENTIAL INTERRUPTIBLE WATER HEATER AGREEMENT

The member agrees to allow Freeborn-Mower Cooperative Services control of the member's water heater by radio control and further agrees to comply with all of the provisions of Freeborn-Mower's Water Heater Control Policy 5.009.

AVAILABILITY

Available for all electric water heaters metered under all rate schedules. All water heaters on this schedule must have an operational control device. Use shall be subject to all other rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. The Consumer shall operate in regular use a standard (Cooperative approved) storage type electric water heater and shall have no non-electric water heating device in use during any part of the year (such as heating coils in a fossil fuel burning range or furnace).
2. The entire installation shall be subject to the approval of the Cooperative for compliance with rules and applicable codes.
3. Provisions shall be made in the Consumer's water heating wiring installation for a socket in which the Cooperative shall install an automatic control unit.
4. Members who purchase a new electric water heater on load control will be eligible for all program benefits from the Cooperative in effect at the time of the installation.
5. Members who have an existing water heater and participate in load control will be eligible for all program benefits from the Cooperative.
6. The Cooperative must be allowed to control the member's water heater for a minimum of five years. IF A MEMBER REMOVES THIS CONTROL OR MOVES FROM HIS CURRENT RESIDENCE BEFORE THE FIVE YEARS HAS ELAPSED, THE MEMBER WILL BE BILLED FOR ANY UNAMORTIZED COSTS REMAINING ON THE WATER HEATER CONTRACT UNLESS THE NEW OWNER/OCCUPANT AGREES TO FULFILL THE CONTRACT COMMITMENT. IN THAT CASE THE NEW OWNER/OCCUPANT WILL NEED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT FOR THE CONTROLLED WATER HEATER WHERE INDICATED.
7. If a member chooses to put their existing electric water heater on the load management program, the Cooperative will install the load management at its expense. The member will be eligible for all program benefits after the load management controller has been installed and the member has signed a 5-year member agreement to stay on load control.
